Who we are!

We provide a community transport service in Cumbernauld, the Northern Corridor and surrounding villages to all non-profit making groups (Schools, Voluntary groups, Churches, Youth Groups). Please note that unless you are exempt, it is mandatory to wear a mask on our buses and that our transport does not offer self - drive hire. All services come with a fully qualified Midas trained driver and where required, a qualified passenger assistant. We operate under a Section 19 Community Bus Permit and are a non - profit making organisation.

What we do!

We support the delivery of food provision and essentials to peoples homes, work with other organisations to meet community transport demand, provide accessibility for service users to attend a series of outings/day trips and transport our service users safely to and from our regular activities and groups.

Our current Community Transport Services

Important - COVID19

Anyone showing symptoms of COVID19 such as; a high temperature, a new or continuous cough, a loss of or change to your sense of smell or taste, is not allowed to travel on CACE vehicles and it is **mandatory** to wear a mask on our buses (unless you have a valid exemption). All of our buses are cleaned regularly via the use of fogging machines that give a layer of protection throughout the bus. Other alcohol based wipes and sprays are available for wiping down within the vehicles. Appropriate hand-wash is available and should be used by each passenger getting on and off the vehicle. There are disposable gloves on board the buses for use when required.

We provide masks for our drivers only, therefore please ensure that if you are planning to use one of our vehicles, that you, or in the case of a group hire, your group have the correct items with them before travel. Currently we have four wheelchair accessible 16 seat vehicles. All have accessible lifts, steps or ramps to enable ease of access inside and are maintained in accordance with current legislation.

Ford Transit – 16 seats with tailgate.

The workhorses of our fleet, these 16 seater adapted Ford Transits are very popular with our groups and are adaptable for a number of uses. Each vehicle is equipped with a powered tail-lift.





Mellor Orion E – 16 seats with tailgate. The newest additions to our fleet. These low floor all electric vehicles are quiet, spacious and ideal for local group outings/journeys for groups or clubs. Each vehicle can accommodate 15 passengers plus the driver and come complete with air conditioning, large windows and an easy climb door ramp. Plenty of handrails and a ramp to the rear for wheelchair access make these the vehicle of choice for many groups. **Costs:** Our pricing system/rates are based on mileage and driver time at £1.20 per mile (first 50 miles) then £1.50) for each additional mile + driver at £10.75 per hour.
